A group of 22 alumni of batch 1965-70 visited the campus on 2nd February 2019, and attended several meetings, hosted by Director Dr. D K Singh, in which students and faculty members participated.

Based on interactions, the group took the initiative to provide financial assistance to a small group of the needy and academically well-performing students of their alma mater.

The scholarship is for a period of two years, starting from 1st August 2019 up to 31st July 2021 and each scholarship is for an amount of Rs 30,000 per year. After the end of the first year the scholarship will be renewed for the second year subject to current recipient achieving a minimum GPA score of 6.5 in the final examination.

To make this a self-sustaining program in long term, each of the awardees is requested to take a soft commitment to support two scholars in their lifetime by contributing to the 1970 Utkarsh scholarship fund. This is purely on a voluntary basis.
